Our new Comms. Officer has quickly got to grips with the technology and learnt how to update the website to post news items. That's great because items can be posted without delay since he's not reliant on the Webmaster finding the time.

He is also up to speed on using the MailChimp software to replace the CSCC mailing list used for announcements. That mailing list will now be retired.

The CSCC's other mailing list for Reps. and Officers will remain although the software it uses is getting rather long in the tooth. For another website I run I have been investigating a modern alternative called Discourse (see <https://www.discourse.org> ). Interestingly it is not just a mailing list but a mailing list and forum combined. I think forums are a useful place for debate and disseminating information which CSCC is missing out on since many of CSCC Officers will not engage with the ukCaving forum. Is there support for a Discourse forum/ mailing list for CSCC?
