5 Chair's report

DC FODCAG have formed as a regional council in the Forrest of Dean. However the boundaries between FODCAG and CSCC have not been clearly defined.

DC We really need an action to define the new boundary between CSCC and FODCAG

GM Does CSCC have clear boundaries. MCRA has a clear boundary to the North, being the county boundary between Bristol and South Gloucester.

DC The northern boundary is pretty vague but the boundary with Wales and DCUC follows the county lines.

GM The borders between regions decide which caves we control. If the border was drawn at the Bristol-Gloucester border CSCC control access to Pen Park hole, FODCAG would control access to Fishmonger's Swallet and 40 Acre Swallet.

AF I am a member of FODCAG, we have written our constitution and it is currently with BCA. I will be happy to circulate a copy to CSCC, comments and observations will be welcome.
